Many, many years ago, I had three Maryland bridges put in when some of my molars had to be extracted. About the same time when Dr. Jang came on board, one by one, the Maryland bridges started to fall out due to decay underneath the crowns that were holding the bridges in place. Dr. Jang was able to save a couple of the molars, but for the most part, they had to be extracted. Most of my "chewing" teeth were gone and I could not chew my favorite foods. I talked to several people who had implants put in by other dentists and some were happy with them and others were not. Dr. Jang explained to me that he wanted a CT scan so he could determine if there was enough room to place the implants. We started on the left side and are working our way around to the right side.

The CT scan on the left side revealed that my sinus was low and he would need to bump it up and add bone graft in order for the implant to be set in correctly. That was scary but as I got to know Dr. Jang, I realized that if anyone could do it, he could. He was and is always patient in explaining ~~the~~ everything to me and answering all my questions and concerns. As we worked around to the right side, another CT scan was ordered. The sinus on my upper right side was even lower than the left side and it would require surgery to separate the sinus from the membrane in order to bump up the sinus — Whoa - no way! We discussed this for a few months and again Dr. Jang kept answering my questions and concerns, and finally I decided to go ahead with the surgery. This was even scarier than the first one. He was successful in separating the membrane and the sinus. Then he put in more bone graft and membrane, closed it up and after 2 weeks, took out the stitches. Now we are waiting for the bone to grow - about 4-6 months, before he can put in the implants. While we are waiting, he is going to put an implant in the lower right side and 2 crowns. Am I happy about all of this — ABSOLUTELY! I am so happy with the result and with Dr. Jang. I am convinced he can tackle any and all dental issues. And by the way, I've kept ~~the~~ the weight off.
